

# RIESLING

## VINTAGE 2014



“John’s father Colin was quick to recognise the potential of the Eden Valley for producing exceptional Riesling and planted vineyards in the early 1960’s. Whilst it is a single vineyard AT Hutton Vale, there are two distinct sections in the block that enables us to produce a very complex wine. The top section, on the leanest soils and more exposed to the wind, produces tightly structured fruit with vibrant natural acidity. The bottom section, on deeper and richer red soils, is marginally more vigorous and produces plumper bunches of fruit that showcase more fresh aromatics and citrus zing.

Aromas of lifted dandelion like florals and powerful flavours of lime are complemented by touches of fresh rosemary, saltbush and honeysuckle sherbet fizz. The flavours linger long after tasting, with the bright citrus drive balanced by a touch of Riesling tannin.”
