EDEN VALLEY RIESLING - 2016 VINTAGE -



“Colin Angas was quick to realise the potential for the Eden Valley to be an exceptional region for Riesling, and planted a vineyard on gentle slope in the 1960’s. Whilst considered a single vineyard, there are two distinct sections. The top section planted on the leanest soils and more exposed to the wind produces very tightly structured fruit with crisp, vibrant acidity. The bottom section, on deeper, more vigorous red soils produces plumper bunches of fruit that showcases more fresh aromatics and citrus zing.

The 2016 Eden Valley vintage was a stand out producing high quality fruit. At Hutton Vale Farm, renowned for some of the lowest yielding vineyards in the district, they experienced yields slightly above the long term average thanks to a mild to warm spring and timely pre-vintage rains in late January.

The Rieslings from Hutton Vale Farm are always beautiful wines and we strive to showcase plenty of varietal character and texture on the palate. There is lovely vibrant lifted lemon zest and lime cordial intermingled with mineral and bath salts notes on the nose. On the palate, there’s fresh lemon and lime, a dash of minerality, refreshing acidity and a long textured chalky dry finish.”
