Dark chocolate, creamy caramel, spice, blackberry, dark cherry. Full bodied, serious tannin structure, grippy and grainy, savoury oak in support, a seam of Barossa coal – structure looms large over the fruit – with a slightly warm and oak spiced finish of excellent length. Leave it alone for about five years."
