Jan looks after the books at Teusner, keeps us all honest...doesn't drink red...but loves our Sauvignon Blanc. Great for us...but bad for Jan...James Halliday had just scored our 2012 wine 94 points and included it in his Top 100 Wines of the year...and lickity split the cupboard was bare. Not happy Jan...at all!

The Barossa is an amazing place...produces brilliant Shiraz, Mataro, Grenache, Riesling...there are few places on earth like it. But great Sauvignon Blanc is just one of those things that alludes us (nobody's perfect)...too warm in February at a time when the ripening grapes need some cool time. So I head to them hills to the South...higher, cooler...Adelaide Hills...better for Sauvignon Blanc.

I reckon this wine has got it all for Sauvignon Blanc lovers...beautiful tropical fruit aromas, plenty of energy on a palate of ripping fresh fruit...but a touch of texture from some fancy foot work in the winery to make it stand out from the pack. Refreshing, zesty, juicy, vibrant....delicious! I reckon Jan will be happy."
